"If a child can't learn the way we teach, maybe we should teach the way they learn"

We have talked about loving and caring for animals that we keep as pets. The next theme 'Creep, Crawl, Fly' will explore some animals in natural surroundings. These creatures live in and around our homes. They will learn about popular insects like butterflies and bees and the less popular ones like flies and mosquitoes, All these are part of Know Your World: a child's world and so in this theme we provide concrete hands-on experiences.

Using plastic models of these creatures, we will continue to count their legs and continue with the textures 'soft', 'smooth' and 'furry'.

Through this theme we will help to develop:

Socio-emotional development:

- Children will experience 'taking turns' and 'sharing' in Dramatic
- Children will learn to care for something.
- Follow safety rules when playing with others
- Function as a part of a large group
- Build respect for nature in them.

Fine Motor Skill Development:

- In keeping with our theme of many legs, we will make children do the toothpick activity to resemble the legs of a spider.
- Manipulating play dough
- Crayoning with up and down strokes
- Finger painting/printing
- Learn to colour inside lines/boundaries.
- Construction Centre
- Pasting with glue stick

Gross Motor Skill Development:

- This theme focuses on exploring different ways in which children can move. We have created several chants and poems for this.
- Butterflies, ladybugs, flies and mosquitoes all fly
 - Children will mimic this by flapping their arms.
- Ants, caterpillars and spiders crawl
 - Children will mimic this by moving on their hands and knees.
- Cockroaches creep Children will mimic this by creeping on their elbows, with their stomachs close to the floor.

Language Development:

Home Activity

- Point out the creatures that live around (birds/squirrel).
- Point out the creatures like- ants, flies, lizards etc.
- Discuss about some creepers and crawlers which they see around them.
- Take your child to the park and point out the birds
- Talk about the insects which are harmful for us.
- Show them how to save themselves from flies and mosquitoes using nets, mesh and sprays.
- Explain how they should take care not to have stagnant water or waste food lying around in their homes and they should also cover the dustbins in their homes.
